AFAM	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
AMER	Y	C-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better.
ART	Y	D-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better.
ASIA	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
BIOL/BMB	Y	C-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better. A student must earn at least a cumulative 2.0 GPA in all courses selected to fulfill the major or minor requirements, whether or not they are listed with a Pass on the transcript.
CHEM	Y	D-, but C- for Chem 220 and 221	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), with following qualifications: the underlying grade in CHEM 220 must be C- or better to move on to CHEM 221; the underlying grade in CHEM 221 must be C- or better to move on to CHEM 300.
CINE	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
COMM	Y	D-	Required courses taken Pass-Fail this Fall will be counted towards the major or minor in Communication as long as a passing grade is achieved.
DMD	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
EBF	Y	C- (D- for minors)	any classes taken toward your economics, business, or finance major in fall 2020 can be taken pass/fail and satisfy major requirements as long as a grade of C- or better is earned for the class. The same is true for students minoring in economics, business or finance, except that there is no grade restriction.
EDUC	N		Education licensure candidates who fulfill Illinois State licensure requirements may <u>not</u> take any course required for licensure (both in their content area or in Education) as P/F. However, exceptions to this policy can be made on an individual basis--please talk with your advisor if you have questions about this.
ENGL	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.

ENTP	Y	C-	Any courses taken toward your entrepreneurship and innovation minor in fall 2020 can be taken pass/fail and satisfy minor requirements as long as a grade of C- or better is earned for the class.
ES	Y	C-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better.
GSWS	Y	D-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses).
HIST	Y	C-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better.
HPP	Y	D-	For COVID-impacted semesters, all HPP courses can be taken for the Pass/Fail option, with no GPA requirement to satisfy successful completion for HPP.
IREL	Y	C	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C or better.
LNAM	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
MATH/CSCI	Y	C-	Courses at the 200+ level that are completed with a "Pass" can count towards our majors/minors, but only if the underlying grade is at least a C- . There's no restriction on 100-level courses.
MLL	Y	C	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C or better.
MUSC	Y	D-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses).
Museum Studies	Y	C-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better.
MUSE	N		Education licensure candidates who fulfill Illinois State licensure requirements may not take any course required for licensure (both in their content area or in Education) as P/F. However, exceptions to this policy can be made on an individual basis--please talk with your advisor if you have questions about this.

NEUR	Y	D	If they are taking it as Pass-Fail and they receive a D grade in it, we will allow it to be counted for the major, but they must still earn at least a C average (2.0) in all courses selected to fulfill the major or minor requirements, whether or not these grades are listed with a P on the transcript.
PHIL	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
PHYS	N		Students may not take any physics course that counts toward the major or minor using the P/F grade. Note that a student may earn a D- or above in a physics prerequisite course and then take the next course (though it is not recommended).
POLS	Y	D-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses).
PSYC	Y	C-	A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better. A student must earn at least a C average (2.0) in all courses selected to fulfill the major requirements, whether or not these grades are listed with a Pass on the transcript.
RELG			A P grade will satisfy all major/minor requirements (including those for prerequisite courses), provided that the underlying grade is a C- or better.
Self-Design	Y	D-	No restrictions on P/F courses in major.
